Licensure Requirements

Christ Centered Ministries is a division of Christ Centered Fellowship, Inc. of Troy, Missouri.

Vision Statement:

Our vision is to see the people of God, who declare that Jesus Christ is their Lord and Savior, supplied with leaders who are fully equipped to help them mature and grow into the work of service the Lord has assigned them to. Christ Centered Ministries (CCM) has been formed to provide the Apostolic oversight and accountability the body of Christ needs in order to grow into the bride of Christ, fully trained to do the work of ministry.

Mission Statement:

Our mission in providing licensing is to train and equip qualified leaders, elders and Five-fold ministers for the work of service in the body of Christ. We have a passion to see each person called to serve in some area of leadership, covered by a Safe, Bible-believing, Apostolic accountability team.

Guiding Scriptures:

Eph. 4:11-13 “And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the [e]difying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.”

2 Tim 4:2 “Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.”

Basic Requirements

Every person wishing to receive a license must complete the application process which is available as a fillable PDF document from our website. In addition to the application, each applicant is to provide a short essay detailing the personal testimony of and the call that God has placed upon the candidate and why the candidate has chosen Christ Centered Fellowship, Inc. to issue licensure. A personal interview with our licensing board, either in-person or online, will also be conducted.

It is not a requirement of CCM that the candidate be a member of Christ Centered Church. The licensed provided will allow the recipient to begin his/her own ministry as the Lord leads.

Educational Requirements

Educational requirements may vary depending on ministry experience. Christ Centered Ministries considers each candidate on a case-by-case basis. Those who have had licensure under a different ministry may submit a summary of life and ministry experiences, and/or “test out” of certain course work. Each type and level of licensing requires different course work.

CCM has partnered with the International School of the Word (ISOW) to provide a strong, Scripturally-based education for those new to ministry. Please see the section, ***Course Catalog***, for more information.

Licenses Available through Christ Centered Ministries

1. Christian Worker

A Christian Worker is a person who is doing a work of service, usually within a local church. This person frequently helps in a local church. They may be a lay leader, a secretary, or just starting a work of ministry with little or no experience in ministry. This person is usually not called to pulpit ministry but is a worker in a support ministry.

2. Exhorter

An Exhorter is a person who is beginning to work in a role of leadership ministry. This person may be a youth leader, a secondary supporting leader (such as an assistant pastor), or is beginning a preaching and/or teaching ministry.

3. Licensed Minister

A Licensed minister is someone who has been in the role of pulpit ministry, either full time or part time, for at least 5 years. This person has been teaching and/or preaching in the pulpit, and may either have their own ministry, or have been appointed as a minister of the Gospel. For those aspiring to become pulpit ministers, but who do not have experience, CCM recommends starting as an Exhorter to complete coursework under the guidance of an experienced minister-mentor. Those who have had pulpit ministry for at least 5 years may apply directly to CCM for licensure. Course requirements would be on a case by case basis, with life experience considered.

4. Ordained Minister

Ordination represents the public recognition of a man or woman called into full-time ministry. To become an ordained minister with CCM, the person must have either previous ordination from a church or ministry or must have proven ministry experience. This candidate must have at least 5 years of experience in pulpit ministry, either full- or part-time, have a letter of recommendation from at least three ordained ministers, and have an interview with our ordination board. CCM loves to honor those who have faithfully worked among us by ordaining them to the work the Lord Jesus has called them to.

Basic Theology

This Basic Theology course taught by Dr. James DuPree offers an in-depth look at the terms and ideas every student of the Word should know about theology. Dr. DuPree discusses the study of theology itself and how it has evolved, the historical context of the Church's various doctrines, the difference between some major schools of thought, and of course the biblical evidence and backing for all of the positions discussed. For any aspiring Bible-scholar or especially to ISOW students new to the ideas presented in serious theological study, this is a great and worthwhile course filled with dozens of references and outside sources, terminology, and Bible passages that confirm or deny commonly held beliefs.

Gifts of the Spirit

1 Corinthians 12:1: "Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant." The first statement in this chapter should be enough to entice us to learn about spiritual gifts. This is one of the most exhaustive teachings ever presented on this subject. Perry Stone captivated a live audience for several days while teaching this course. You should leave this course with a comprehensive knowledge of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and how they operate in the church and the lives of believers.
